FOR AGES 0-67 MILLION.

We welcome visitors all ages; like SUE, one of the largest Tyrannosaurus rexes in history. (67,000,000 years old is a lot of birthdays.) Then there's SUE's neighbor, a mummy still preserved in his Egyptian tomb. Or, an entire continent worth of Native American storytelling. At the Field Museum, it's not just where in the world you can go, but when.



Start Exploring

SUE the T. rex and Maximo the Titanosaur are part of the Griffin Dinosaur Experience,





When Shermann "Dilla" Thomas started a TikTok account in 2020, he began posting videos of his family and stories about one of his favorite topics — the history of Chicago. Just two years later, Dilla has become known as the city's unofficial urban historian, sharing fascinating facts about "the greatest city on earth" to more than 90,000 followers as @6figga_dilla.

"It's one thing to see a picture or see a name on a street sign or a building, but it's not personal," says Dilla. "Telling the story of how that thing or that person came to be or came to prominence, I think hearing those stories keeps history relevant."

The success of his videos led Dilla to launch **Chicago Mahogany Tours**, a series of neighborhood bus tours that immerses visitors and locals in the rich history of the city's south and west sides.

"I'm of the belief that if you know the history of a place, you can't help but

respect it," says Dilla. "History can adjust your perspective. And so many things can be accomplished if you're moving with the correct perspective."

We asked Dilla to share some of his favorite Chicago spots, from little-known historical sites to can't-miss neighborhood history.

BEST SPOTS FOR NATURE LOVERS

In Chinatown, there's **Ping Tom Memorial Park**. The architect, Ernie Wong, is a Chicagoan of Asian ancestry. I love that he understands both cultures, and you can see that and feel that there. The two marry each other.

You gotta go to **Auburn Park** in Auburn Gresham. It has an original lagoon from the 1800s.

I'm also a very big fan of **Maggie Daley Park**. I like that it preserves

the downtown lakefront while also honoring a really cool Chicagoan. And my kids love it.

BEST UNDER-THE-RADAR PIECES OF CHICAGO HISTORY

There's **The National Museum of Puerto Rican Arts & Culture** in

Humboldt Park. It's a great example of preservation — the building was formerly a horse stable designed by a famous architect. Now it's being used in a thriving Puerto Rican neighborhood, honoring Puerto Rican history.

I also tell people to go to the **Victory Monument** on 35th and King Drive in Bronzeville. It honors the Black World War I veterans.

And you gotta go to the **Union Stock Yard Gate**. Chicago was formerly
the largest meatpacking source in









the country, and the gate is now a National Historic Landmark.

BEST RESTAURANTS FOR FOOD WITH A SIDE OF HISTORY

I would say Valois in Hyde Park. You watch them make your food behind the counter. It's been around for 100 years — and anybody that's had any kind of political power in the city of Chicago in the last 100 years has eaten there.

And you should go to La Luna in Pilsen, at 18th and Racine. It's Mexican cuisine, and serves

probably the best taco in the city. There's a hidden gem a few blocks away at Benito Juarez High School, where there are life-size sculptures of all the leaders of Mexico from throughout history.

BEST PLACES TO CATCH A SHOW

I like Metro. The terracotta on the exterior is amazing. It's a repurposed building, so it preserves history while allowing us to enjoy the present.

Reggies in the South Loop is awesome. I love its proximity to Chess Records and the old Chicago blues scene.

And we gotta add Buddy Guy's Legends. It's owned by Buddy Guy, who does a residency there every January. Where else can you walk in and literally see a living blues legend and icon?

BEST NEIGHBORHOODS FOR HISTORY BUFFS

Bronzeville, for sure. Black History Month as a concept comes from Bronzeville, along with gospel music, Ida B. Wells-Barnett, and the Harlem Globetrotters who integrated basketball, to name just a few.

There's also the **Pullman** neighborhood. President Barack Obama designated Pullman as a National Monument, but the Pullman neighborhood has been making history since the late 1800s. It's because of the Pullman railcar strike that we have Labor Day as a holiday. And the architecture and infrastructure of Pullman are original to the neighborhood.

And I wish more people went to **North** Lawndale. It's home to a rich Jewish history, the original Sears Tower, and has ties to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Make sure to take a Chicago Mahogany Tour to see all of these awesome neighborhoods I'm talking about.





PULLMAN

When the Pullman National Monument was built in the 1880s as a town for the workers who manufactured luxury train cars, it was considered one of the most beautiful industrial communities in America. Start your tour at the Visitor Center, housed in the recently restored clock tower. Then stop at the Hotel Florence. the hotel that once accommodated railroad CEOs and dignitaries. At the National A. Philip Randolph Pullman Porter Museum. learn about the African American labor movement and attend the annual Juneteenth Celebration. Pullman residents open their doors to the public during the **Historic** Pullman House Tour.

HYDE PARK

The University of Chicago is the academic and cultural epicenter of Hyde Park. Take in a performance at the Reva and David Logan Center for the Arts or see a show at the Court Theatre, recipient of the 2022 Regional Theatre Tony Award. See more than 5,000 ancient artifacts from the Middle East on display at the Oriental Institute Museum. View a wide range of visual arts, from ancient Chinese prints to provocative contemporary works, showcased at the Smart Museum of Art. Architecture buffs won't want to miss Frank Lloyd Wright's Prairiestyle masterpiece, the Frederick C. Robie House.

Nearby, The DuSable **Black History Museum** and Education Center in Washington Park highlights African American history, culture, and art. Peruse contemporary art at the Hvde Park Art Center or learn via the hands-on exhibits at the Museum

of Science and Industry. Connect with nature at the Japanese-inspired Garden of the Phoenix in Jackson Park, home to Yoko Ono's **SKYLANDING** sculpture, a steel representation of unfolding lotus petals. The circa 1923 Stony Island Arts Bank is now a modern art gallery, media archive, and creative community hub in the close by South Shore neighborhood.

BRONZEVILLE

Historically known as the city's "Black Metropolis," Bronzeville is a center of Black culture in Chicago. Hop aboard the Bronzeville Art District Trolley Tour and visit local galleries. Stroll the stretch of Martin Luther King Drive that features the Monument to the Great Northern Migration, the Victory Monument, and the many murals along the Bronzeville Walk of Fame. Founded in 1940, the South Side Community Art **Center** is the oldest African American art center in the U.S., serving as an artistand community-centered resource and offering an inspiring array of public exhibits and events. Admire works by emerging and established Black artists and stroll the Great Migration Sculpture Garden at Gallery Guichard. There are great dining options throughout the neighborhood, with favorites that include Pearl's Place, Norman's Bistro, and Bronzeville Winery.

CHINATOWN

Chicago's century-old Chinatown transports visitors straight to China, minus the long airplane ride. Pass through the picturesque Chinatown Gate that marks the entrance to Wentworth Avenue, home to Chinese bakeries, dim sum eateries, and charming gift shops. The Chinese American Museum of





Chicago promotes culture and history through public exhibitions and educational programming. The outdoor Chinatown Square mall, located just north of the main Wentworth Avenue district, offers numerous cafes, boutiques, and a plaza surrounded by statues of the 12 animal signs of the Chinese zodiac. Nearby. check out the colorful Nine Dragon Wall mosaic. The most scenic way to get to Chinatown is via a Chicago Water Taxi ride from the Loop to the neighborhood's idyllic Ping Tom Memorial Park. where visitors are invited to picnic, play, kayak, and enjoy the pictureperfect city skyline views.

PILSEN

Pilsen offers a vibrant glimpse into Mexican American life in Chicago. The free National Museum of Mexican Art celebrates Mexican culture and history through captivating exhibits and special events. Tortillerías, family-run restaurants, bars, breweries, and vintage boutiques line

18th Street. Vivid, large-scale murals abound along 16th Street. The Pilsen Arts & Community House is a space where local artists come together to showcase and develop their talents. The Chicago Arts District hosts a monthly gallery night with free receptions at the many galleries and studios along Halsted Street. The landmark Thalia Hall sets the stage for a wide array of music and artistic events, and also houses old-school Dusek's Tavern, cocktail-forward Punch House, and the cozy Tack Room bar.

WEST TOWN

Waves of immigrants shaped West Town into the creative, eclectic enclave it is today. On its main commercial avenues, Chicago Avenue and Grand Avenue, you'll find some of the city's hottest breweries and restaurants. The area is also home to Ukrainian Village, where you'll find cultural artifacts and history exhibits at the Ukrainian National Museum, and contemporary artwork at the Ukrainian Institute

of Modern Art. Intuit: The Center for Intuitive and Outsider Art promotes the understanding and appreciation of art outside the mainstream through rotating and permanent exhibits.

LOGAN SQUARE

Logan Square is a hip, creative neighborhood. Its hot dining scene offers everything from Michelinrated restaurants to buzzy bars and breweries. With its majestic, 19th-century mansions, stately Logan Boulevard leads to the heart of the neighborhood and the eagle-topped Illinois Centennial Monument. Chicago blues grace the small stage of the familyowned Rosa's Lounge, while the Concord Music Hall hosts artists of all genres. from punk to electronic to hip-hop. Rent a Divvy bike and ride The 606, a 2.7-mile recreational trail that was once an abandoned rail line.

HUMBOLDT PARK

Iron Puerto Rican flags flank Paseo Boricua, Humboldt Park's cultural corridor that stretches along Division Street between Western and California avenues. Learn about Puerto Rico's artistic contributions at

The National Museum of Puerto Rican Arts & Culture. housed in the landmark

Humboldt Park stables. Or take a deeper look into the neighborhood's hidden gems with a walking tour



hosted by the Paseo Boricua Tour Company. Paddle the tranquil lagoon in a swan boat, swim at **Humboldt** Beach, and explore the trails of Humboldt Park, the neighborhood's namesake park. Dine at one of the neighborhood's many traditional Boricua eateries, and be sure to try a jibarito (a fried plantain sandwich invented in Chicago). Or check out Ørkenoy, a brewery, restaurant, and cocktail bar with an artsy edge, located in the Kimball Arts Center. Don't miss the Puerto Rican People's Parade, an annual summer event that honors the community's Puerto Rican identity.

ALBANY PARK

Albany Park is one of the most diverse neighborhoods in the country. See a performance celebrating Spanish culture at the Ensemble Español Spanish Dance Theater. The Albany Park Theater Project hosts live shows that highlight its international namesake

neighborhood. Learn more about a rich heritage that dates back more than 4,000 years at the National Cambodian Heritage Museum. Snack on Filipino street food while you shop at Seafood City Supermarket.

UPTOWN

In the 1920s and '30s, Uptown was a booming entertainment destination. The Green Mill takes patrons back to its Prohibition Era heyday and still hosts live music almost every night. On Argyle Street, an endless array of Asian restaurants serves everything from banh mi to dim sum. The annual Argyle Night Market (July - September) offers alfresco fun, including pop-up eateries and live performances. Catch a show at the Black Ensemble Theater, known for its excellent musicals depicting notable African Americans. The Pride Arts Center presents queer theatre, movies, and comedy.

CHICAGO ON **SCREEN**



Chicago's neighborhoods have served as the backdrop for some of the most memorable films and television shows of all time. The crew of *Chicago* PD hangs out at Lottie's Pub in Bucktown. Scenes for Patsy's Pies, owned by the character Fiona in Shameless, were shot at Golden House Restaurant & Pancake House in Uptown. The big shootout in *The Untouchables* was filmed at Union Station. The characters of **Chicago** Fire attend the real-life training center for the Chicago Fire Department — the Chicago Fire Academy. Ferris Bueller's Dav Off included a trip to see a Cubs game at Wrigley Field, while pop geek Rob Gordon (Chicago's own John Cusack) caught a flick at the Music Box Theatre in High Fidelity.

A knowledgeable, friendly staff and unparalleled selection of books, including an extensive collection of LGBTQ+ literature, has earned Northalsted's Unabridged Bookstore

many fans. Check out the sale book section.

Stocking more than 20,000 books, including works by and about women, children's books, and the latest LGBTQ+ literature, Andersonville's **Women & Children First** is one of the country's largest feminist bookstores, celebrating underrepresented voices since 1979.



Equal parts bookstore and art showplace, River West's Semicolon Bookstore & Gallery celebrates community and inclusion, reflecting its provenance as the city's first bookstore owned by a Black woman.

In the heart of Logan Square, female-owned and operated **Wolfbait & B-Girls** lovingly celebrates artisan clothing, gifts, personal care, art, and jewelry made by more than 300 Chicago designers.

DINING

Expect continuous party vibes at Northalsted's **Kit Kat Lounge & Supper Club**, which features nightly drag queen diva performers, 30-plus martinis, and delicious contemporary American cuisine.

Six-time Michelin Bib Gourmand-recipient **Wood**, a stylish Northalsted restaurant, spotlights local purveyors in dishes like house-made charcuterie and pasta. Its innovative bar program adds to its charm.

Coastal Southern cuisine, heirloom ingredients, heartfelt hospitality, and an extensive whiskey and bourbon selection all define Andersonville's charming **Big Jones**, from beloved chef Paul Fehribach.

Paying homage to her grandmother, chef Dominique Leach of Pullman's Lexington Betty Smokehouse offers Chicagostyle barbecue brisket and pork with plenty of soulful sides, including gussied-up candied yams.

Family-owned **Hing Kee Restaurant** has been a
Chinatown favorite since
2007, earning plenty of loyal
fans for its handmade soup
dumplings, traditional pulled
noodles, and authentic
Cantonese food.

From the same owners of one of the city's oldest gay bars, the South Loop's Williams Inn Pizza & Sports Bar celebrates Chicago's Black and LGBTQ+ communities, serving madeto-order deep dish pizza.

Specializing in comfort food made with impeccable ingredients and paired with inventive cocktails, West Town's **Split-Rail** is a cozy neighborhood restaurant paired with a retro basement cocktail bar called **Dorothy**.

At **Kale My Name**, Albany Park's globally inspired, 100% plant-based restaurant and bar, dietary restrictions are fully (and deliciously) embraced, with dishes ranging from cauliflower buffalo wings to veggie sliders.

NIGHTLIFE

Since 1982, Northalsted's **Sidetrack** has been providing a welcoming and inclusive space for its many fans with boozy slushy drinks, a year-round rooftop, showtune nights, and pride for the community it serves.

Since its Pride Week 2003 opening, Northalsted's **Hydrate** quickly became Chicago's top place for dancing, drag shows, theme nights, and music sets from the industry's best DJs into the wee hours of the morning.

Nobody's Darling, a James Beard Award nominee in Andersonville, offers a classy, laid-back lounge vibe with a menu of creative cocktails inspired by influential women.













For 53 years, Uptown's The Baton Show Lounge has been wowing guests with its award-winning drag revues. Up the festive atmosphere with boozy frozen drinks and gelatoinfused cocktails.

Five nights a week, the South Loop's **Lips** Chicago offers Vegas-style drag shows paired with contemporary American cuisine and festive cocktails. Sunday Lips Drag Brunch features unlimited beverage specials.

A laid-back Uptown neighborhood bar with good vibes to spare, Big Chicks consistently tops Chicago's best LGBTQ bar lists. Revive the next day at sister spot Tweet, which specializes in hearty breakfast, lunch, and brunch fare.

As one of the country's longest-running Blackowned gay bars, Jeffery Pub is a beloved LGBTQ+ gathering space in the South Shore neighborhood.

ATTRACTIONS

Along a half-mile stretch of Halsted Street in Northalsted, The **Legacy Walk** features rainbow landmarks that commemorate notable LGBTQ+ individuals whose achievements have helped shape the world.

Located in Rogers Park and founded in 1991, the Leather Archives & Museum offers community archives, a library, and a museum of

leather, kink, fetish, and BDSM history and culture.

Founded in 1981, Gerber/ Hart Library and Archives

in Rogers Park is the largest circulating library of gay and lesbian titles in the Midwest, with more than 14.000 volumes, 800 periodical titles, and 100 archival collections.

Celebrate the life and work of social justice activist Jane Addams at the Jane Addams Hull-House Museum. the settlement house she co-founded in 1889, which still stands today.

CHICAGO RIVER

Stroll the 1.25 miles of the Chicago Riverwalk to take in the full scope of riverside fun. Visit the **McCormick Bridgehouse** & Chicago River Museum and discover the gears and inner workings of the city's famous moveable bridges. Absorb the serenity

of the fountains and view commemorative markers at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Plaza. Browse the locally made goods at the Community Marketplace. Enjoy the views, bites, and sips at the riverfront cafes and beer gardens.

Head to the Chicago Architecture Center (CAC)

to learn how Chicago became known as "the city of architecture," with interactive exhibits about our diverse neighborhoods, soaring skyscrapers, and influential architects. The CAC also offers tours, cruises, and programs to showcase Chicago's iconic architecture.

On shore, enjoy stunning Lake Michigan views and tasty dishes at The Lakefront Restaurant. nestled inside the landmark Theater on the Lake.

Play on one of Chicago's many beaches that dot its 26 miles of lakefront. Dip into the lake at Oak Street Beach, popular for sunbathing and people watching. North Avenue Beach is noted for its sand volleyball tournaments. At 63rd Street Beach, catch free music at **Reggies on** the Beach. And Rainbow Beach offers one of the city's best skyline views. Try water sports like standup paddleboarding with Chicago SUP and jet skiing with **Jet Ski Chicago**, both offered at North Avenue Beach. DAY 1

MORNING Head to the iconic Art Institute of Chicago, one of the oldest and largest art museums in the world, home to works ranging from Impressionist masterpieces to contemporary marvels.

Keep the art appreciation going with a visit to the **Chicago Cultural Center**, a major hub for art exhibits, live music, lectures, films, and dance set in a beautiful Loop landmark.

AFTERNOON Another staple of Chicago's diverse arts scene, the Museum of Contemporary Art Chicago features new and experimental works by leading contemporary artists.

Stimulate your curiosity and your senses at the **WNDR Museum**, which features interactive, immersive experiences from an international

who's who of artists, studios, and collectives.

Located inside a 1920s building transformed into a stunning work of art, **Wrightwood 659** features exhibitions of architecture and socially engaged art.

EVENING A treasure for visitors and locals alike, Millennium Park is a 24.5-acre culture lover's dream, from the Harris Theater for Music and Dance to the Frank Gehrydesigned outdoor Pritzker Pavilion that hosts a roster of free concerts.

If live theatre is more your jam, **Broadway In Chicago** delivers with five stellar downtown theatres, featuring some of the country's best touring musicals and plays.

At the Loop's **Goodman Theatre**, Chicago's oldest and largest not-for-profit theatre, expect an exciting

schedule of classic and modern works.

For more than 20 years, **Congo Square Theatre Company** has dedicated itself to staging transformative works rooted in the African Diaspora.

With its gorgeous art deco interior, a visit to the **Lyric Opera of Chicago** rewards in many ways beyond the outstanding performances.

Ranked as one of the premier dance companies in the world, the **Joffrey Ballet** performs classical and contemporary ballets, including its beloved annual holiday presentation of *The Nutcracker*.

DAY 2

MORNING In Washington Park, The DuSable Black

History Museum and Education Center is a treasure trove of African and African American history, culture, and art with permanent and visiting exhibitions.

Located in the Pilsen neighborhood, the **National Museum of Mexican Art** showcases 3,600 years of creativity from both sides of the border, representing the diversity of Mexican culture.

AFTERNOON Lovers of the written word won't want to miss the **American Writers Museum**, an interactive museum that spotlights great writing in all its genres through exhibits, events, and author visits.

A place where legendary music magic was made, Chess Records is home to Willie Dixon's Blues Heaven

Foundation, which offers tours of the famed recording studio that spawned hits from artists such as Buddy Guy, Muddy Waters, and Chuck Berry.

Once the 1883 residence of a wealthy Chicago banker, the **Driehaus Museum** has been lovingly restored inside and out. It features permanent and temporary exhibitions showcasing the Gilded Age and beyond.

EVENING Michigan Avenue's Symphony Center does double duty, acting as home base for the prolific Chicago Symphony Orchestra, as well as hosting classical music programs and special open rehearsals.

Refining the landscape of acting and performance since 1974 with an ensemble cast that has included John Malkovich and Pulitzer Prize-winning Tracy Letts,

Steppenwolf Theatre

Company plays are always must-see events. A recent multimillion dollar expansion includes a stunning 400-seat theatre-in-the-round.

With a mission to eradicate racism through theatre, the **Black Ensemble Theater** has become a vibrant, internationally renowned arts institution in the Uptown neighborhood.

For more than 60 years, The Second City has been making audiences laugh with its unique form of improv comedy, which includes a variety of nightly shows at its multistage Old Town venue.

Rooted in African American dance, music, and folklore. Muntu Dance Theatre brings audiences out of their seats and into the aisles with its unique synthesis of dance, rhythm, and song.



FAMILY FUN IN CHICAGO

Chicago is the ultimate family playground, with adventures that await at beautiful parks and world-class attractions.

Stare into the eyes of a lion at the new Pepper Family Wildlife Center within the always-free Lincoln Park Zoo. Beautifully landscaped Brookfield Zoo is home to acres of animals from every corner of the world in suburban Brookfield.

At Navy Pier, kids can take a spin on the 200-foot-tall Centennial Wheel, ride an old-fashioned merry-goround at Pier Park, catch a family show at **Polk Bros** Park, or "drive" a CTA bus at the Chicago Children's Museum. The Pier's fireworks light up the night sky throughout the summer.

Mingle with over 1,000 fluttering butterflies in the Judy Istock Butterfly Haven at the Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum

The Chicago History Museum challenges kids to catch a fly ball at the White Sox's ballpark or morph into a giant Chicago-style hot dog.

Skydeck Chicago whisks families from its new Chicago-themed museum experience to the 103rd floor of the Willis Tower. Only the brave dare to step onto The Ledge, a set of glass-floored balconies that extend four feet out from the skyscraper.

On the 94th floor of the former John Hancock Center, the 360 CHICAGO observation deck offers bird's-eye views of the city. Step onto TILT, a glass ledge that tilts outward, 1,000 feet above Michigan Avenue.

Let the kids run free at Maggie Daley Park. Ice skate in the winter or rollerblade in warm

weather on the Skating Ribbon. Or let the whole family try different types of rock climbing on the 40-foot Climbing Wall, with beginner and advanced areas.

One of the many highlights of The Forge: Lemont Quarries adventure park in suburban Lemont is the 1.000-foot zip line that whizzes across a picturesque quarry lake.

The Museum of Science and **Industry** in Hyde Park makes learning fun, inviting kids to stand at the epicenter of a tornado or descend into an Illinois coal mine.


The lakefront Museum Campus is home to three amazing institutions. At the Field Museum, guests are greeted by Máximo, the largest dinosaur that ever lived. Kids can watch dolphins leap into the air at the Shedd Aquarium. And explore the depths of space at the historic Adler Planetarium.

FREE THINGS TO DO

A variety of our city's attractions, from flower-filled conservatories to landmark museums, are free to see and explore. We've rounded up a list of standouts to get you started.

The Pullman National Monument showcases the first planned industrial community in the United States, and was designated a National Monument by former President Barack Obama. See where Pullman train car employees lived and worked in the 1800s.

Spanning a full city block, the Chicago Cultural Center is a Loop landmark. Home to the world's largest Tiffany stainedglass dome, it features gallery exhibits, music and dance performances, and building tours of its outstanding architecture.

Big Marsh Bike Park is a 297-acre bike park on the southeast side of the city that includes more than five challenging tracks for biking (with bike rentals available), nature trails for hiking, and a beloved birdwatching spot.

Whether you're taking selfies at Cloud Gate (also known as "The Bean"), splashing around in Crown Fountain, strolling through Lurie Garden, or seeing a concert at the Jay Pritzker Pavilion, there are endless opportunities

for fun in Millennium Park. For music lovers, check out the park's free festivals, including the Chicago Gospel Music Festival, Chicago Blues Festival, Chicago Jazz Festival, Grant Park Music Festival. and Millennium Park Summer Music Series.

Dance lovers won't want to miss the Chicago SummerDance series. Whether you want to learn how to salsa or two-step, this series features dance lessons and live music at parks across the city.

For a deep dive into the artistry of Mexican culture, the National Museum of Mexican Art is a must-visit in Pilsen. The museum showcases everything from photography collections to film and paintings.

Both the Lincoln Park Conservatory and Garfield Park Conservatory highlight the best of

botanicals, featuring thousands of palms, plants, and flowers. These lush indoor gardens transport you to a tropical environment that can't be beat.

AUTHOR'S TIP

The Harold Washington Library Center, one of the largest public libraries in the world, features the sun-filled Winter Garden that makes for a picturesque place to stop and recharge as vou're exploring the Loop.

Norman's Bistro in

Bronzeville specializes in Cajun-Creole fare, with highlights that include shrimp and catfish po' boys, chicken gumbo, and sausage jambalaya. Stick around for the DJs spinning everything from house to R&B in **The Bar**, along with live jazz music on Sunday nights.

Husband-and-wife team Beverly Kim and Johnny Clark have garnered James Beard Awards and Michelin stars for their inventive contemporary Korean cuisine at **Parachute** in Avondale. Eclectic beverage options, including soju, cocktails, and wine, pair with haemul pajeon seafood pancakes and pork bossam accented with kimchi.

In River North, discover **Jaleo** by world-renowned chef José Andrés. Dine on traditional Spanish tapas like gazpacho, Spanish tortillas, and spicy chorizo wrapped in crispy potatoes, along with massive pans of paella, all served with panache.

For Chinese classics like Peking duck and sizzling beef tenderloin, head to **Evergreen Restaurant** in Chinatown. Cantonese cuisine is the specialty here, but regional favorites from Szechuan like kung pao shrimp and twice-cooked pork also appear on the menu.

If you're in the mood for Mexican food, **Lonesome Rose** in Logan Square is open for dinner and weekend brunch, slinging tacos, burritos, and frozen mezcal margaritas. There's also vegan queso, made with coconut milk and nutritional yeast. Be sure to check out **Golden Teardrops**, the restaurant's hidden basement bar.

AUTHOR'S TIP

Be sure to try a bubble tea in Chinatown — the ultrapopular Joy Yee offers lots of colorful, fruity versions.













Arami in West Town is a longtime favorite for high-quality sashimi, nigiri, and makimono sushi rolls at reasonable prices. You'll also find Japanese favorites like fried chicken karaage and grilled Japanese yellowtail collar.

In Hyde Park, 14 Parish Restaurant & Rhum Bar is open late on weekends, dishing out Caribbean flavors with flair. Try the coconut shrimp, jerk chicken, and red snapper escovitch paired with more than 100 varieties of rum from the bar.

HaiSous Vietnamese Kitchen is known for its warm service and excellent Vietnamese food in Pilsen. Chef Thai Dang modernizes dishes he grew up with in Hanoi. such as the whole fried fluke and chicken wings in caramelized fish sauce.

Galit earned a Michelin star for the bright Middle Eastern flavors it serves up in Lincoln Park. Lamb

kebabs, wood-roasted cabbage with saffron mudjara, and silky-smooth hummus are accompanied by the fluffiest pita in Chicago for dipping.

Since her Top Chef victory, Stephanie Izard has become one of Chicago's most recognized and beloved chefs. Cabra is her latest restaurant in the West Loop — a colorful Peruvian rooftop with refreshing ceviches, beet tiradito, and crab causas.

OUTDOOR DINING SPOTS

Mexican street food and ice-cold beer attract baseball fans on game days at the two-story Big Star Wrigleyville that overlooks historic Wrigley Field.

The roof deck at Gibsons Italia draws a sophisticated clientele with house-made pastas, wagyu steaks, and sweeping views of the Chicago River.

The playful patio at Recess in the West Loop serves elevated childhood favorites like loaded tater tots while guests play giant Jenga surrounded by repurposed shipping containers.

Chow down on fried chicken sandwiches and hush puppies at Parson's Chicken & Fish, featuring lively patios at all four of its neighborhood locations.

James Beard Awardwinning chef Erick Williams serves elegant but hearty Southern fare like blackened catfish and buttered grits from breezy sidewalk tables at Virtue.

The All Stations Accessibility Program is committed to making 100% of Chicago's rail stations fully accessible for all riders.

All CTA train cars feature priority seating and designated wheelchair areas, accessible doors and ramps, Braille signage, interior LED signs displaying announcement

text (on certain cars), and automated voice announcements for routes and stops.

CABS AND RIDESHARE SERVICES

Passengers can request a wheelchair-accessible cab by calling 888-WAV-CABS (888-928-2227) or using the **CURB** app. Riders can also request a wheelchairaccessible vehicle with the Uber app.

Chicago has made it a mission to become one of the most accessible big cities in the country. The city offers a variety of resources to increase accessibility for travelers with disabilities or mobility devices within airports, public transportation, and beyond. CHICAGO'S **AIRPORTS**

O'Hare and Midway International Airports

both offer various accommodations to help travelers with disabilities get to and from Chicago safely and conveniently, including accessible parking, restrooms, service animal areas, and special accommodations during

BUSES AND TRAINS

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) operates 129 bus routes that make stops throughout the city and surrounding area. All of Chicago's CTA bus routes feature accessible buses for riders with disabilities. These buses are equipped with ramps, designated priority seating, wheelchair securement areas, audio announcements inside and outside of the vehicle, and accompanying text on LED displays for route and stop information.

Chicago's rapid transit train system, known as the 'L,' serves more than 140

CHICAGO O'HARE & MIDWAY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS



Chicago sits conveniently in the center of the country and boasts two awardwinning airports. Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD) lies just 17 miles from downtown Chicago and is one of the busiest hubs in the country. A mere 10 miles from downtown, Chicago Midway International Airport (MDW) is a premier pointto-point airport, offering leisure and business travel

MOST CONNECTED AIRPORT IN THE WORLD

to nearly 80 destinations.

In 2022. O'Hare took the title of "most connected airport in the world" for the first time since 2016, replacing London for the top spot according to Official Aviation Guide (OAG) - the global authority on air service information.

Chicago's airports are hubs to three of the four largest carriers in the United States — American Airlines, United Airlines, and Southwest Airlines. More than 45 passenger airlines provide nonstop service

from Chicago to over 250 destinations worldwide, offering visitors their choice of carrier. Four airlines offer flights out of both O'Hare and Midway: Delta Air Lines, Frontier Airlines, Southwest Airlines, and Volaris.

This is the most exciting time for Chicago's airports in 30 years — travel is rebounding and with the support of its partner airlines, the two airports are thinking big for the future.

NEW AT O'HARE

An ambitious plan to modernize the airfield was completed in 2021 and O'Hare now has eight total runways — the most of any commercial airport in the United States. This historic project (building four new runways, extending two existing runways, and constructing two new Air Traffic Control towers) has improved capacity, efficiency, and reliability in all weather conditions.

Following the major investments on the airfield, O'Hare is pivoting to the

next area of focus - its terminals. The "O'Hare 21" project is well underway and will enhance the experience from curb to gate for millions of passengers arriving each year. At the forefront are plans to redevelop Terminal 2 into the O'Hare Global Terminal and add two new satellite concourses. At 2.25 million square feet, this will more than double the space of today's Terminal 2, replacing it with an expansive light-filled arrivals hall with additional gates, concessions, and amenities; new baggage systems; and advanced security screening. American Airlines, United Airlines, and their alliance partners will be able to consolidate operations here, meaning easier domestic and international connections.

10 NEW GATES AT **TERMINAL 5** At 350,000 square feet, the Terminal 5 extension at O'Hare now boasts bigger gate areas, expanded seating, new restrooms, and more amenities — with additional restaurants and shops coming in 2023. Seven new gates in Concourse M opened in 2022, with three more opening in 2023. Large bright windows offer airfield views, while open seating areas, modern furniture, and plentiful charging stations provide comfort and convenience. The expansion brings the total number of security checkpoint lanes to 13 and also improves immigration facilities.

A NEW HOME FOR DELTA IN TERMINAL 5 In October 2022. Delta Air Lines relocated from Terminal 2 to the newly renovated

Terminal 5. The move enables Delta Air Lines and its SkyTeam partners to combine domestic and international flights within the same terminal making connections quick and seamless. Relax and recharge before flights at the new Delta Sky Club. At over 22,000 square feet, it is four times the size of the previous O'Hare location and the largest premium passenger lounge that Delta offers outside of its hub airports.

NEW AT MIDWAY

The Midway Modernization Program — the most significant capital program at Midway in nearly 20 years elevates the travel experience for visitors and is nearly complete, preparing the airport for future growth.

SHOP, DRINK & DINE

Over the last several years, restaurant and retail openings included 30 locations, including Café Descartes (specialty coffee drinks), Gene's Bistro (crowd-pleasing salads and sandwiches) and Billy Goat Tavern (an undisputed Chicago landmark). The newest offerings? Local favorite Garrett Popcorn Shops near Gate B1 and cocktails, seafood, burgers, and more at The Orange Line near Gate B19.

DOUBLE THE CAPACITY

An 80,000-square-foot security pavilion opened in September 2020, touting new technology and a wider, streamlined TSA checkpoint with 23 lanes that double previous capacity while maintaining the highest levels of security. Visitors will see reduced wait times during peak periods with the TSA now able to process as many as 5,000 passengers per hour.



TAKE THE 'L' TRAIN TO & FROM THE AIRPORT

- Best fare into town: Just \$5 (including any transfers to other lines)
- Fly direct to the Loop with fast, frequent service (under 45 minutes to downtown)

O'HARE Catch the CTA Blue Line at O'Hare Station, which directly connects to Terminals 1, 2, and 3. Use the Airport Transit System (ATS) to connect to Terminal 5.

MIDWAY The Midway Station of the CTA Orange Line is located next to the airport terminal and connected by an enclosed walkway.

REFRESHING BREWS



→ QUICK EATS

Handhelds from fast-casual favorites, like thin crust pizza from Home Run Inn (MDW Concourse B) or a fried chicken sandwich from Big City Chicken (MDW Concourse B), are great on the go. Burger Federation (ORD Terminal 3) touts the "Best Burger in the City" with its Little Miss Figgy Burger.

→ KIDS' PICKS

For your lil' flyers, touch down at Woodgrain Neapolitan Pizzeria (MDW Concourse A) for a mini cheese pizzetta and fruit combo. Sports fans will find chicken fingers and "Pitcher's Pasta" on the junior meals menu at Chicago Cubs Bar & Grill (ORD Terminal 3).

GRAB A BIKE

Chicago's Divvy bike-sharing program is an inexpensive and easy way to get around. Thousands of bikes are available at hundreds of stations across the city. Single rides are \$1 to unlock and \$0.16 per minute. Or try Divvy's ebike, with a pedal-assist motor. Pay \$1 to unlock the ebike, plus \$0.39 per minute. divvybikes.com

TRY A WATER TAXI

Seasonal water taxis are a scenic and budget-friendly way to reach points of interest along the Chicago River and Lake Michigan. Take a ride with Shoreline Water Taxi (shorelinesightseeing.com) or Chicago Water Taxi (chicagowatertaxi.com).

CTA fares start at \$2.25 for buses and \$2.50 for trains with a reloadable Ventra card. Single-ride Ventra ticket: \$3 (includes three rides within two hours of use) or \$5 (from O'Hare Airport). One-day Ventra ticket: \$10 (unlimited rides for 24 hours). transitchicago.com


